Directions

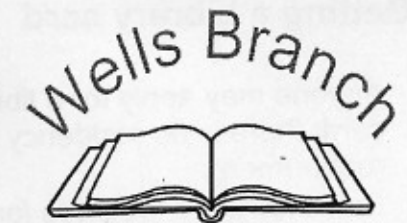
The library is located at the T intersection of Wells Port Drive and Alpha Collier Drive.

From 1325/Burnet Road

Travel north on 1325 past Parmer Lane to the light at Wells Branch Parkway. Turn right. Continue until the light at Wells Port Drive. Turn left. The library will be several blocks north on the right.

From IH 35

Travel north on IH 35 to the Wells Branch Parkway exit. Turn west on Wells Branch Parkway. Turn right on at the light at Wells Port Drive. The library will be several blocks north on the right.

The mission of the Wells Branch Community Library is to provide access to reference and reading materials in the form of print or other media to people within the Wells Branch Community and neighboring areas.

Getting a Library card

- Anyone may apply for a library card; there is no residency requirement.
- Currently there is no fee for your first library card. You will need to present a valid ID (either a current Texas driver's license with correct address or a photo ID and a piece of mail with the person's name and address, such as a bill).
- Children can be issued their own library cards but must be accompanied by their parent when applying. Parent must show ID.

Borrowing Materials

- Most Library materials are checked out for a two week period and may be renewed once if the item has not been placed on "Hold" for someone else.
- Movies are limited to 5 items, only check out for one week, and cannot be renewed.
- Late fees are assessed on each item each day: 25 cents for print, 50 cents for audio, \$1 for video.



Computer Services & Internet Access

The Wells Branch Community Library provides high-speed public access to the Internet on a first come, first served basis.

Access periods are limited to 30 minutes when patrons are waiting.

All minors must have a completed permission form on file at the library to use a computer.
